



Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation is often key to a full and fast recovery following a serious injury, and it is important to begin the process immediately. In many cases, waiting for the end of court proceedings and the payment of financial compensation can mean that rehabilitation starts too late to make any real difference.

This is one of the reasons why claimants are allowed to ask for substantial interim payments of damages at a very early stage of their claim. Interim payments can be used to pay for rehabilitation which will maximise recovery, improve quality of life and where possible, speed return to work.

How do I establish that I need rehabilitation?

Where it is clear that you need rehabilitation beyond that which the NHS can provide, your solicitor and the defendants' insurer will together arrange an independent assessment of your case. The assessment is outside the civil claims process, ensuring that the assessment is entirely about giving you the best chance of making a swift recovery.
